1. CoS Outstanding Jr. Research Faculty Award

Award: \$1,500

Eligibility: Non-Tenure Track Junior Research Faculty, to include Post Docs, Post Doc Affiliates, and Visiting Assistant Professors that have been at Georgia Tech for 1+ year(s) are eligible for this award. Individuals who won a CoS research faculty award within the past two years are not eligible for this award.

Criteria: Exceptional contribution and proven accomplishments in research with significant impact on the awardees field of study. Candidates will be evaluated based on research contributions including publications, presentations, and other products of their research performed at Georgia Tech.

2. CoS Outstanding Sr. Research Faculty Award

Award: \$1,500

Eligibility: Non-Tenure Track Junior Research Faculty, to include Research Scientists, Research Technologists, Research Engineers and Research that have been at Georgia Tech for 1+ year(s) are eligible for this award. Individuals who won a CoS research faculty award within the past two years are not eligible for this award.

Criteria: Exceptional contribution and proven accomplishments in research with significant impact on the awardee's field of study. Candidates will be evaluated on the basis of to the area of research including publications, presentations, and other products of their research performed at Georgia Tech.

3. CoS Research Faculty Community Trailblazer Award

Award: \$1,500

Eligibility: All Non-Tenure Track Research Faculty, to include Post Docs, Post Doc Affiliates, Visiting Assistant Professors, Research Scientists, Technologists, Engineers, and Associates, that have been at Georgia Tech for 1+ year(s) are eligible for this award. Individuals who won a CoS research faculty award within the past two years are not eligible for this award.

Criteria: Demonstrated and sustained leadership that strengthens the sense of community among research faculty within the College of Sciences.
